- 1. Accommodation fee is calculated from the first night of arrival until the day of departure. This is normally from Sunday (arrival) to Saturday (departure).
- 2. Upon receipt of application form you will be sent an invoice of which a 25% non-refundable deposit must be paid to secure the place. The remaining balance must be paid 4 weeks prior to student's arrival.
- 3. All bank charges to be borne by the client. All payments must be nett of bank charges.

- 6. Cancellations within 30 days of arrival date are liable to 50% of the total cost.
- 7. All activities and programmes are subject to change and Accent reserves the right to cancel or modify the programme where necessary.
- 8. Students must be with their Host Families by 10.00pm at the very latest and only with written consent from the parents.
- 9. Insurance: although we do our best to ensure an enjoyable and safe stay for all of our students, no insurance cover is provided by Accent or the Host Families. Therefore, for their own wellbeing, we insist that students (under 18) provide a copy of a valid Travel Insurance Policy which covers Health, Accidents, Luggage and possessions etc. for the duration of their stay. A copy of the Travel Insurance Policy must be submitted to Accent prior to arrival.
- 10. Photographs may be taken during activities sessions for promotional material and on our website. If you do not wish for photos to be used for this purpose, please let the activity leader or our office staff know as soon as possible.
- 11. Any issues, disputes, or complaints must be raised by either the student or student's parent/guardian during the stay so that we may attempt to rectify the issue. No refund or compensation will be given to any issue being raised after student's departure.
